Circuit Judge Tiffany M. Baker is having her formal investiture in her hometown of Quincy, FL, Friday, May 20, 2022, at 3:00 p.m. It will be held at the Gadsden County Courthouse, 10 East Jefferson Street, Quincy, FL, 32351. Judge Baker was elected to the circuit bench on November 3, 2020, making her the youngest female and youngest African American to be elected Circuit Judge of the Second Judicial Circuit.

Before her career started on the bench, Judge Baker worked in private practice as a criminal defense attorney and family law practitioner. Before launching her practice, she worked as an associate attorney for one of the local personal injury firms, litigating, negotiating, and settling personal injury claims. Judge Baker received her Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from the University of Miami in 2007 and her Juris Doctorate from Howard University School of Law in 2012.

Judge Baker currently resides in Tallahassee as a happy wife to Leonard W. Carper, Jr., and proud mother to two beautiful girls, Phoenix Ray and Lenox Luna. She is a member of the Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Inc., Chi Upsilon Chapter, and other civic organizations.
