All registered voters in Leon County are eligible to elect Supervisors for this Board as seats are countywide.

Term begins 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday after 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in January.

The candidate who receives the largest number of the votes cast within each group of candidates in such election shall be the elected Supervisor for such district. In the case of a newly created district participating in a regular election for the first time, three groups of candidates shall be elected for terms of 4 years, and two groups shall be elected for initial terms of 2 years.

In the event of a vacancy resulting from death, resignation, removal, or otherwise, each vacancy shall be filled by appointment by the remaining Supervisors of the District until the next regular election.
