County Commission & SOE (NPA)	<p>County Charter: Sec. 3.2(A) Non-Partisan Election Procedures. If three or more candidates, none of whom is a write-in candidate, qualify for such office, the names of those candidates shall be placed on a non-partisan ballot at the first primary election. In no candidate for such office receives a majority of the votes cast for such office in the first primary election, the names of the two candidates receiving the highest number of votes for such office shall be placed on the general election ballot.</p> <p>F.S. - 105.051(1)(b) If two or more candidates, neither of whom is a write-in candidate, qualify for such an office, the names of those candidates shall be placed on the ballot at the primary election.</p> <p>F.S. - 100.041(2)(a) Each county commissioner from an odd-numbered district shall be elected at the general election in each year the number of which is a multiple of 4, for a 4-year term commencing on the second Tuesday following such election, and each county commissioner from an even-numbered district shall be elected at the general election in each even-numbered year...</p>	<p>3 or more qualified candidates PRIMARY-if no majority, top two vote getters go to General; 2 qualified candidates GENERAL (takes office upon certification of election)</p>
City Commission (NPA)	<p>City Charter: Section 7-4 - Election date. The regular election of the city shall be held on the first Tuesday after the first Monday in November of each even numbered year. The municipal primary election for the nomination of mayor or city commissioners if necessary, shall be held on the same date as the State's Primary Election.</p> <p>Section 7-6 - Primary election and unopposed candidates. If two or more persons qualify as candidates as provided for in section 7-5 for any of the places to be filled, then a municipal primary election shall be held for election for all vacancies wherein more than one candidate is thus qualified...</p>	<p>2 or more qualified candidates PRIMARY-if no majority, top two vote getters go to General; (takes office 17th day after certification of election)</p>
School Board (NPA)	<p>F.S. - 105.051(1)(b) If two or more candidates, neither of whom is a write-in candidate, qualify for such an office, the names of those candidates shall be placed on the ballot at the primary election.</p> <p>F.S. - 100.041(3)(a) School board members shall be elected at a general election for terms of 4 years.</p>	<p>2 or more qualified candidates PRIMARY-if no majority, top two vote getters go to General; (takes office the 2nd Tuesday following the General Election)</p>
County Judge (NPA)	<p>F.S. - 105.051(1)(b) If two or more candidates, neither of whom is a write-in candidate, qualify for such an office, the names of those candidates shall be placed on the ballot at the primary election.</p>	<p>2 or more qualified candidates PRIMARY-if no majority, top two vote getters go to General; (takes office the first Tuesday after the first Monday in January following the election)</p>
Ochlockonee (NPA)	<p>F.S. - 582.18(1) The election of supervisors for each soil and water conservation district shall be held every 2 years. The elections shall be held at the time of the general election provided for by s. 100.041.</p>	<p>GENERAL highest vote wins; (takes office the first Tuesday after the first Monday in January following the election)</p>
CDD (NPA)	<p>F.S. - 190.006(3)(b) Elections of board members by qualified electors held pursuant to this subsection shall be nonpartisan and shall be conducted in the manner prescribed by law for holding general elections.</p>	<p>GENERAL highest vote wins; (Board members shall assume the office on the second Tuesday following their election.)</p>
Constitutional Offices except SOE	<p>Article VI, Section 5(b), Florida Constitution - Universal Primary; If all candidates for an office have the same party affiliation and the winner will have no opposition in the general election, all qualified electors, regardless of party affiliation, may vote in the primary election for that office.</p>	<p>2 or more qualified candidates of the same party PRIMARY-if no majority, top two vote getters go to General; (takes office the first Tuesday after the first Monday in January following the election)</p>
