

If you are unable to make it to your polling place on Election Day, and have no means of transport to an Early Voting location, by all means we still want you to vote! Simply call our office at (850) 606-VOTE, or (850) 606-8683 to request your ballot be mailed to you.

AT YOUR PRECINCT

Voting at your precinct on Election Day is your last option to cast your ballot in an election. Voting hours are 7 a.m. until 7 p.m. Be sure we have your current residence address so that you appear at your proper polling location and bring a picture ID with your signature to present to the poll worker. To avoid congestion at your precinct, vote in the non-rush hour time frames of the day.
