Qualifying Method: 1. Qualifying Fee – \$5,371.20\* (\*subject to change based on salary); or  
2. Petition Method – submit 1,684 valid petitions which is equal to 1% of the total number of registered voters for each corresponding district in the 2010 General Election.

All registered voters in Leon County are eligible to elect County Judges as seats are countywide.

Unless otherwise provided by general law, no person is eligible for the office of county court judge unless the person is, and has been for the preceding five years, a member of the bar of Florida.

Term begins 1<sup>st</sup> Tuesday after 1<sup>st</sup> Monday in January.

If a vacancy occurs, it shall be filled in accordance with Article V, Section 11 of the Constitution of the State of Florida.
