Required Reading:

- Vergil's *Aeneid* in English. Any translation is permitted but the following is recommended as the newest and most modern translation.
 - Virgil's *Aeneid*. Translated by Robert Fagles. ISBN: 978-0-14-310513-8

Assignment:

- Summary of the *Aeneid*. A summary of the *Aeneid* is due on **Friday, August 23rd, 2013**. There should be at least 1 paragraph per book/chapter and should cover all of the major characters and events of each book/chapter. This should be typed using New Times Roman 12 point font and should be double spaced.

Required Reading:

- Caesar's *Gallic War* in English, books 1, 4, 5 & 6. Any translation is permitted including the online translation from www.Perseus.Tufts.edu.

Assignment:

- Summary of Caesar's *Gallic War*. A summary is due on **Friday, August 23rd, 2013**. There should be at least 1 paragraph per book and should cover all of the major characters and events of each book. This should be typed using Times New Roman 12 point font and should be double spaced.

Recommended as supplementary reading:

- Homer's *Odyssey*. Again, any translation is permitted but the following is recommended as the newest and most modern translation.
 - Homer's *Odyssey*. Translated by Robert Fagles. ISBN: 9780140268867
- Homer's *Iliad*. Any translation is permitted.

Recommended Grammar and Vocabulary Work for all levels:

- Wheelock's Latin – It is recommended that you all continue reviewing both your Latin Grammar and your Latin vocabulary over the summer.
