

The Florida Constitution grants homeowners an exemption up to \$50,000 on the appraised value of their home. This year a full exemption is worth \$813.00 in tax savings.

Attention Homeowner:

Our records indicate you purchased property in Leon County during 2014. If you live on the property and it was your permanent residence on January 1, 2015, you may be eligible for Homestead Exemption. Please review the reverse side of this card for more information.

- Visit the Property Appraiser's office weekdays, 8:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m., 3rd floor in the Leon County Government Annex Building, 315 S. Calhoun Street, behind the Leon County Courthouse or visit one of our six community filing centers.
- Mail your completed application to Leon County Property Appraiser, Post Office Box 1750, Tallahassee, FL 32302-1750.

In order to make application the following is needed for all applicants:

1. Florida driver license or Florida identification card
2. Social Security number
3. Florida vehicle tag number and/or voter registration card


